RESIDENCE HALL INFORMATION

Union College was designed to be a residential campus, and two-thirds of full-time students live in one of three residence halls—two for men and one for women. Most students choose to have a roommate, although you can have your own room for an additional fee if there is availability. Rees Hall, the women's residence, and Culver Hall, one of the men's residences features community bathrooms on each hall (which means you don't have to clean them), while Prescott Hall, a men's residence, features two-room suites with a bathroom between.

Students will qualify to live off campus if they plan to live with a family member or are 22 years old. Students who are 21 may apply to live off campus.* All room assignments are made after we receive your Campus Housing Request form. AVAILABILITY

The number of available units varies from semester to semester. Rental arrangements for summer and fall are usually made in April and May, so contact the housing manager as soon as possible.
